



INTERNATIONAL EXPERT, AUTHOR, TO KEYNOTE PALMCON III

LHMI is pleased to announce that **David Hormachea** of Corona, CA, renowned expert on family-centered ministries, will be the keynote presenter at the third <u>Partners in Latino Ministries</u> (PALMCON III).

It will be held October 16-18, 2019, in El Paso, Texas.

Dr. David Hormachea is the founder and president of "Regreso al Hogar" ("Return Home"), an organization dedicated to helping families. He has served in Chile, Ecuador, and the United States as pastor and leader of various radio and television ministries. Dr. Hormachea has published 16 books, most of which deal with family issues. He will discuss how leaders in Hispanic/Latino ministry can help their own families and the families of others through the love and power of Christ. Dr. Hormachea will be the main presenter.

PALMCON participants will be able to learn from Dr. Hormachea, other presenters and each other as they network among themselves, nurture their faith, leverage resources, and worship together.

PALMCON will have presentations in English and Spanish. Translation services will be available throughout the duration of the conference.
